

Pesticide Recordkeeping Form for Private Applicators

This form combines information required for Restricted Use Pesticides (RUP)¹ and the Worker Protection Standard (WPS)²

¹ RUP designates information required for Restricted-Use Pesticides. This information must be completed within 14 days of application and must be kept for 2 years.

² WPS designates information that must be provided to workers/handlers for all pesticides with “**Agricultural Use Requirements**” on the label. This information must be posted **before application** and **remain for 30 days after the end of the Restricted Entry Interval (REI)**.

³ Multiply Rate by Size of Area Treated to get Total Amount Applied (not the quantity after water or carrier added).

⁴ If you apply a tank mix of pesticides with different Restricted Entry Intervals, write down the longest REI.

Note: For applications made to less than 1/10th of an acre, indicate “spot treatment” and record: location of area treated; brand name; EPA Reg. No.; Month/day/year; and Total Amount Applied.
