There are 3 levels of recognition: (1) Initiative, (2) Program, and (3) Leadership levels. Your application material will be evaluated and rated accordingly. The honorees will

- i). Receive media coverage for their pest management program. A press release and picture of the school district representative will be sent to their public information office for publishing in their school district newsletters and to the local newspaper and TV station.
- ii). A letter will be sent to their local state senator, representative and school board about describing their efforts;
- iii) Attractive plaques, certificates, IPM related publications and literature are included in the package.
- iv). Travel to Raleigh to attend the recognition ceremony prepared specially them
